## ANNUAL REPORT – 2025

This year has been a remarkable journey of growth, learning and achievements. With a strong commitment to holistic education, the school has continued to provide academic excellence, leadership opportunities, extra-curricular enrichment programs. This report provides an overview of the major accomplishments and activities that shaped out school vibrant and dynamic environment.

### Academics:

In this academic year our students worked hard and achieved excellent results in all classes. Teachers used new teaching methods and activity-based learning to make lessons engaging. This year we have installed 50 inches Televisions in each class to improve their learning and understanding skills. Several students participated in many categories like quiz, spell bee, storytelling, recitation and inter-school competitions, bringing pride to the school.

On the National Science Day from class-V and above students prepared a model and presented and discussed on those projects.

### Teacher Development:

### Parents Orientation Program:

In this regard, we ensure that parents are actively involved in the academic journey and co-curricular activities of their children. To foster this collaboration, coming year we are planning to organize a comprehensive Parents Orientation Program at the beginning of the academic year.

Co-curricular activities are equally important in shaping well-rounded individuals. This year, we organized a lot of art integrated activities. We also observed major festivals on campus, celebrating each one in a unique way.

\*On 5<sup>th</sup> of April, we celebrated our annual Foundation Day and on the same day we had a Investiture Ceremony where we selected all the school representatives like school captain, vice-captains, house captains through the process of voting.

\*On 5<sup>th</sup> of June, we celebrated the World Environment Day by planting saplings and cleanliness of our school surroundings.



\*On 13<sup>th</sup> July, school participated in the annual Bhanu Jayanti celebration in Tarpin Secondary School and Rongli, whereby the students managed to secure 1<sup>st</sup> position in dance and 2<sup>nd</sup> position in Ramayan Path.



\*On 15<sup>th</sup> of August, flag hoisting ceremony was held at 8 AM at Greenwood Academy. Our school participated in various competitions across different venues. At Rongli Government School, our school competed with 11 schools, secured a place in the top 3 and on the final day achieved the 2<sup>nd</sup> position in the dance competition. In the Seventh Day Adventist School our junior football team showcased great spirit by defeating many teams and emerged as the runner-up in the finals, where Jasper Lamgadey & Asumit Phuel of class-VI won a man of the match awards.



\*On 13<sup>th</sup> September, we celebrated Pre-Dashain with great enthusiasm and cultural spirit along with Sanskriti Manthan where talent was showcased through shlokas, recitation, skit by students of I/II/III in Ramayan and speeches in Sanskrit. This year our students celebrated Raksha Bandhan with army jawans and speech given regarding Rakhi in hindi language.



\*This year we organized an inter-school football tournament in the name of Damber Singh football tournament from 9<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> of October and around 22 schools had participated in the football tournament. On the last day i.e. on 18<sup>th</sup> Oct. we ended the 9 days long programme by Pre-Diwali celebration and Octofest. Where students presented bhailini and deusi. On the same day we conducted inter-school spell bee and dance competitions whereby our students again bagged the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> position respectively.



\*On 19<sup>th</sup> October, NHIDCL conducted a small G.K. Quiz Competition among our students in hindi language where our few students won the cash prizes from them.

\*On 31<sup>st</sup> October, our school was selected with other 104 schools in UDAAN Inter School Scholastic Festival at SMIT, Majhitar where our Honorable Chief Minister was there as a chief guest and our students participated in many competitions like Word power, Speed Maths, Spell Bee, Creative Writing, Poster making Group dance and able to won many Medals and made us proud.



\*On the same day our school was also awarded by Minerva in recognition in providing quality co-educational learning and fostering holistic student development.
